Notice and Procedure for Making Claims of Copyright Infringement Pursuant to the Digital Millennium Copyright Act.

If you believe you have a legitimate copyright infringement claim, please submit notice of it to the following designated agent:

The notification of your alleged copyright infringement should be submitted in writing via email and should include...

- A statement and proof that you are the owner of the exclusive rights to the material(s) which you claim has been infringed or
- A statement that you are authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right of materials that has allegedly been infringed.
- A sworn statement, under penalty of perjury, that the information which you are submitting is true and factual.
- Your signature (which may be digital).
- Identification of the copyrighted work you allege has been infringed. (If more than one copyrighted work, please list them all as one allegation.)
- Identification of the material you claim has been infringed and sufficient information about it in our material and also where you have it listed as copywrited to enable SendReach.com to find and resurch it.
- Your contact details: postal address (Not a PO Box or redirected address), telephone number, and email address (Not a web service email such as Hotmail or Gmail).

- Contact details of the owner of the copyrighted work you claim has been infringed if you are not the owner but are authorized to act on their behalf.
- A statement that, to the best of your knowledge, the way the copyright has been allegedly infringed is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.

By sending a claim you agree that DET is not liable because it has received it from you and that you agree that you are only informing us of a potential infraction and the DET does not agree to be held liable by just receiving this information from you.
